Methodology – Mobile Apps

- We conducted a systematic study on 18 mobile applications
- From 2013-2017, CITC blocked all VoIP call services
- In 2017, CITC announced to lift the ban
- We evaluated their connectivity from 2018 to 2020

Relation Between Geopolitical Events and *Digital Filtering*

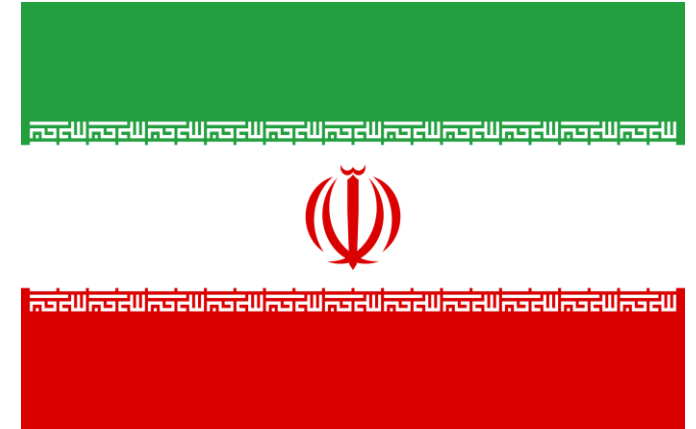
- ISIS-friendly websites were blocked
